## BOND ELECTION

SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2016

*On February 15, 2016, the Liberty Hill Independent School District's Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call a \$35 million bond election to address student and program growth, aging facilities, and safety and security.*

*This bond will allow for construction of the district's third elementary school to alleviate overcrowding.*

*This bond also includes improvements to the existing Liberty Hill Elementary School to address aging conditions and increase security measures. In addition, it provides for new and expanded agriculture facilities – an evolving and growing Career and Technology pathway for our students.*

### Take a Closer Look at What's Proposed



#### New Elementary School

To be built on district-owned property located in the Rancho Sienna subdivision and serving grades PK-5 at a capacity of 800 students.



#### Liberty Hill Elementary School

Safety and security improvements: new controlled entry vestibule and access control system, new intercom system and additional exterior lighting.

Other general upgrades: replace flooring, repaint hallways and classrooms and replace ceiling tiles.



#### Liberty Hill Intermediate School

New plumbing equipment and safety eye wash station in the science lab to meet current code compliance and replacement of remaining ceiling tiles not included in the 2010 bond program.



#### Career & Technology Education: Agriculture Facilities

Construction of a show arena and renovation of existing facilities to accommodate additional animal pens, wash stations and storage.

New program spaces that currently do not exist will be provided such as restrooms, locker rooms, laboratory, an enclosed shearing area and concessions.



#### Land Acquisition

Use of bond funds as available toward the purchase of land for future district facilities.

**TOTAL BOND AMOUNT: \$35,000,000**

*No tax increase. If approved by voters, this bond will be funded within the district's existing tax rate and will create no change to the existing tax rate.*

# LIBERTY HILL ISD GROWTH

Liberty Hill ISD continues to see significant growth. In 2010, enrollment projections anticipated our growth to be 3,281 students by 2016, an increase of almost 700 students.

As of January 2016, we exceeded that projection as student enrollment reached 3,480, a growth of more than 8%.

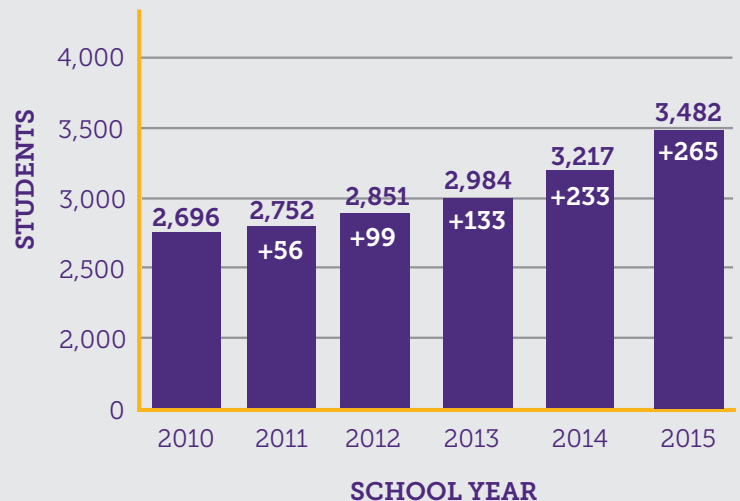
